How to Study the Bible

READ

R

As you prepare to read, first take a moment and prepare your heart and focus your mind with a simple prayer. “Lord, here I am”. Read the passage, maybe more than once.

EXAMINE

E

What is the context, who is talking, who are they talking to, what issue is being addressed, etc.? Ask the basic questions of who, what, where, when, why and how. Then finally, what did I learn?

APPLY

A

How does what I read apply to my life? How do I need to live? Consider reading with a pen in hand, noting comments, questions, and applications. Don't be afraid to mark the text with underlines, circles, etc.

PRAY

P

Look at your reading time as a conversation: God speaks to you through Scripture. As you respond to God in your heart & interact with His Word, spiritual truth comes to life.

What to look for when you read

If you keep a journal, write down your responses to your reading: look for lessons to learn, examples to follow, promises to claim, and truths to guide your life.

Consider writing out your prayers & keeping track of how God answers. Think about who else might be blessed by what you read today.
